



2025 Porto to Lisbon

Event Overview: Saturday 26th April - Thursday 1st May

Portugal always provides the perfect backdrop for a supercar event, with incredible roads with little traffic, breathtaking scenery, with hotels and hospitality to rival any destination in the world. This year we are starting at a brand new luxury hotel that has immediately become a member of the Leading Hotels of the World. We then continue south into the Alentejo region and a truly relaxed oasis that is the *Alentejo Marmoris*. Our final day of driving sees us wind our way back to the coast and the *Ritz-Carlton's Penha Longa* resort in Lisbon, where we will celebrate at the Michelin-starred *Midori* restaurant.

Saturday 26th April

5* Six Senses Douro Valley, Samodães

A happy change of circumstances means we are more than delighted to say that our start hotel will now be the absolutely gorgeous Six Senses Douro, a world-renowned spa hotel. It is stunning, so we advise everyone arrives early to soak it all in.



Drivers will meet for drinks and our Driver's Briefing where we will run through the plan for the week, before a relaxed meal in the hotel's *Vale Abraão Restaurant*, which has a stunning terrace with river views and seasonal menus of regional dishes.



Sunday 27th April

5* Maison Albar Amoure, Braga, Porto

We are immediately located on some of the best driving roads in Northern Portugal and have an epic day ahead of us. From the moment we start driving, it is clear why we have come to Portugal, with it's stunning roads and countryside. We are driving around the best parts of the Douro Valley through forests and along the river as we wind our way towards our destination. We are stopping in a fabulous restaurant for lunch, before descending onto more empty ribbons of tarmac that wind their way towards our destination hotel.



Our hotel for the evening is a new member of The Leading Hotels of the World, the *5* Maison Albar Amoure*. Owned by a supercar collector, it is perfectly geared towards a great stay for us. You will have time to enjoy the spa before cocktails in *RPM*, and then dinner in their excellent restaurant.



Monday 28th April

5* Casa de São Lourenço, Manteigas

We turn south on Monday and head towards the highest location in Portugal, the *Burel Mountains*. Fantastic roads await as we head through the forests and across the *Douro River*. We have some incredible sections of tarmac to conquer, such as that pictured above, and will wind our way through the town of *Torre de Moncorvo* where we will stop briefly for lunch.

The 5* Casa de São Lourenço awaits after an epic climb up through the forests into the mountains. The hotel's idyllic location is our base for two nights as we settle in for more epic driving ahead. It has breathtaking views with it's floor to ceiling glass façade and a great spa.

After drinks by the fire, we will go through to a fabulous dinner with a stunning vista out over the mountains below.



Tuesday 29th April

5* Casa de São Lourenço, Manteigas

Our second day in the *Burel Mountains* offers us the opportunity to drive the surrounding roads, which are widely regarded as some of the best in the country. The area is home to several hydroelectric dams and quiet service roads which provide the perfect location to explore the region. The surrounding *Serra da Estrela Nature Park* incorporates the highest mountains in Portugal, and guarantees a superb day of driving.





Wednesday 30th April

5* Alentejo Marmòris, Vila Viçosa

Wednesday has one of the best driving sections we have encountered anywhere, our beloved "Canyon Road", which cuts along the side of a valley and seems to go on forever. It is a truly special bit of tarmac that sees us descend from the mountains towards the Alentejo region. We stop for lunch alongside the *River Tagus*, before continuing on our journey south into the *Alentejo* region.



Our destination is the fabulous 5* Alentejo Marmòris Hotel & SPA, a member of the Small Luxury Hotels of The World. We have been visiting for half a decade, and are always enamoured with the warm welcome and the fabulous outdoor pool. This is yet another fantastic location to relax in after a great day's driving. Dinner will be in the hotel's award-winning Narcissus Fernadesii restaurant.



Thursday 1st May

5* Penha Longa Resort, Lisbon

On Thursday we head west towards the coast and the city of *Lisbon*. We start by driving out towards the *Spanish* border before we double back on ourselves and head into the *Portuguese* countryside. We have some fast sections of road as well as more challenging passes through the hills, as we make our way towards the city of *Lisbon* and our destination for the final evening.



Our hotel is the Ritz-Carlton's fabulous 5* Penha Longa Resort. The hotel sits amidst the lush landscape of Sintra's rolling green hills within a natural park, and has a wonderful spa.
